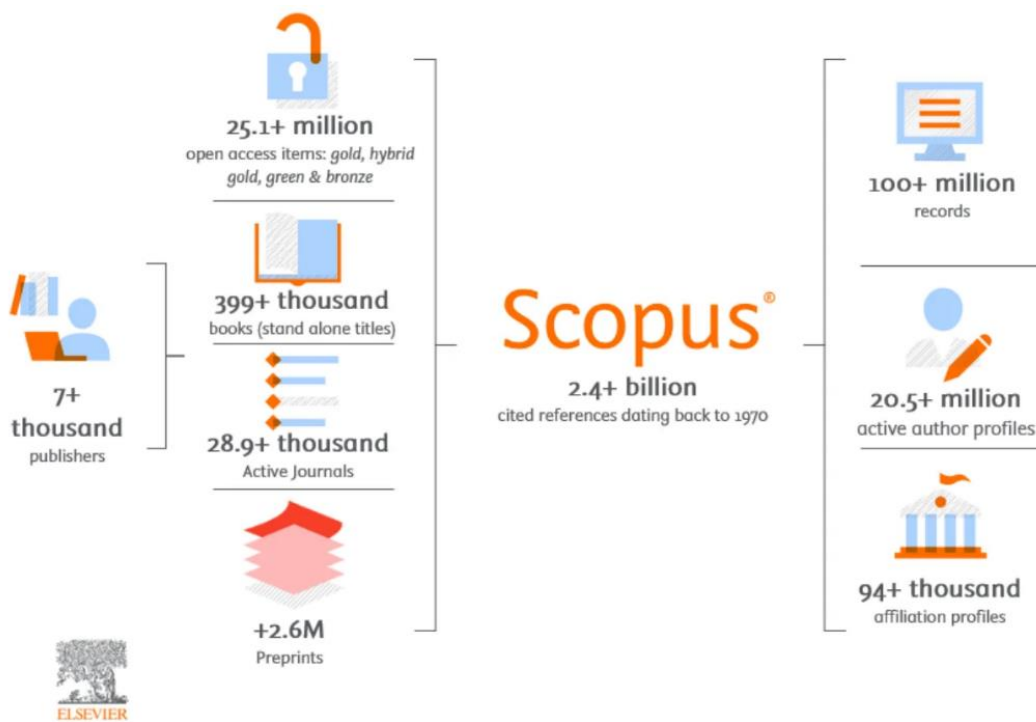

**Scopus** on maailma suurim teaduskirjanduse andmebaas, kus on rohkem kui 25 000 teadusajakirja, sh üle 5500 avatud juurdepääsuga (*Open Access*) ajakirja, lisaks raamatupeatükid, konverentsikogumikud jm. Scopus kuulub **Elsevieri kirjastusele**, selles on infot 330 teadusalalt (eraldi sõjandusvaldkond puudub). Teematilisi ajakirju jm võib leida nt valdkondade *Social Sciences: Political Science and International Relations* ja *Social Sciences: Sociology and Political Science* alt.

## INFOPÄRINGUTE VÕIMALUSED SCOPUSES

**I Documents:** artikli, raamatupea-tüki vms otsing. Otsing erinevatelt väljadelt, mida saab rippmenüüs vahetada. **Fraasiotsing:** kui vähemalt 2 sõnast väljend asetada jutumärkidesse, otsitakse täpselt selliliseid väljendeid, mis annab täpsamad ja asjakohasemad tulemused. Ilma jutumärkideta asetatakse sõnade vahele vaikimisi operaator AND – otsingu tulemuseks on artiklid, kus kõik sõnad asuvad, kuid need ei pruugi olla täpselt samas järjestuses, mistõttu on tulemuste hulgas ka palju mitteasjakohaseid. Soovi korral võib võtmesõna katkestada tärniga (\*), et leida sõna erinevad grammatilised lõpud ning vajadusel kasutada küsimärki sõna sees (metamärgiga otsing, *wildcards*), et leida viidetes esinevate sõnade erinevad kirjpildid (nt *defen?e* otsitakse *defence* või *defense*).

As will be argued, the shift from European to Eurasian power and Russia's carefully crafted management process of not exceeding red lines, as well as its process of exploiting the socioeconomic weaknesses of the west all play a relevant role in understanding the political context. 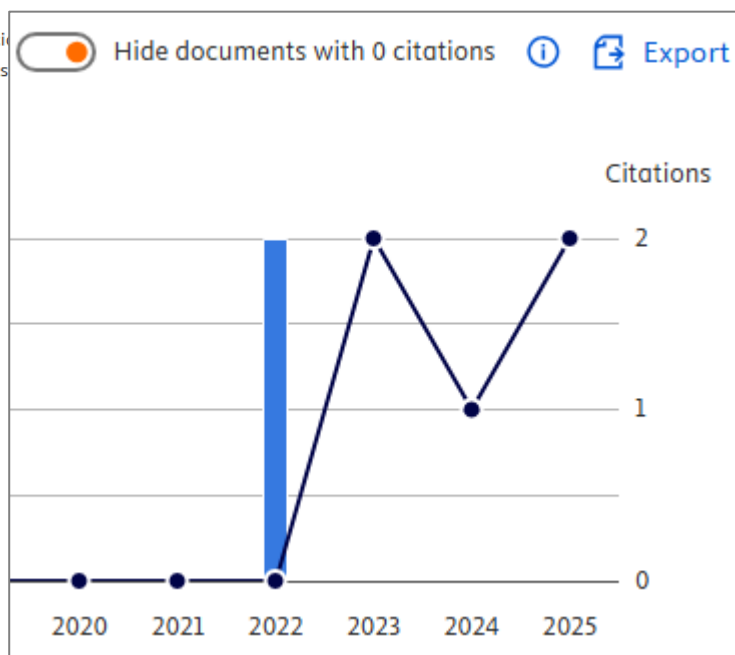
